R. M. Jolley on the 4 day of February 1907, ordered survey of Section 20 Township 31 Range 15 East. notices were sent on the 4th day of Feby, 1907 to R. M. Jolley, A. Hubbard and E. J. Means, Independence, Kas, Clarine Johnson La Fontaine and Elk City, Kas, Mr. J. H. Conner, Fredonia, Kas and Neodesha, Kas, D. C. Dillman, H. Bunker, A. J. Boyle, E. W. Linnion (Means) & H. Goff M. Martin, Elk City, Kas. To meet at Reading of R. M. Jolley, Feb. 19, 1907, at 8^{am}. Feby, 19, 1907, met at time and place appointed. Upon investigation I find the north and south $\frac{1}{4}$ posts with marks and descriptions answering those of the government. I start at the N $\frac{1}{4}$ post run south on true line, Va $9^{\circ} 45'$ East, I find that the distance to the south $\frac{1}{4}$ post is 5274 feet. I correct back and set C $\frac{1}{4}$ post. Limestone 16x10x5. Marked C $\frac{1}{4}$. at a distance 2637 feet from the north and south $\frac{1}{4}$ posts on the intersection of the east and west $\frac{1}{4}$ line. I find the distance on the north line of section to be 5280 feet. I run west from north $\frac{1}{4}$ post 1320 feet set stake for temporary ~~west~~ north $\frac{1}{4}$ post. I continue west on same line 1320 feet and find that the corner to sections 17, 18, 19 & 20 is missing. I then start at the south west corner of section 20, run north on true line ²⁶³⁷ feet. set stake for temporary west $\frac{1}{4}$ post, which I find missing. I continue north on same line 1318.5 feet set stake for temporary north west $\frac{1}{4}$ post I continue north on same line 1318.5 feet to intersection of east and west, section line of sec. 20. I set Limestone 16x10x8, marked on east side III, on south side III, for corner to section 17, 18, 19 & 20. For temporary W $\frac{1}{4}$ stake I plant Limestone 16x10x4, marked on east side $\frac{1}{4}$, and for NW $\frac{1}{4}$ temporary stake I plant Limestone 16x10x4, marked on east side NW $\frac{1}{4}$. From the C $\frac{1}{4}$ post I run north on true line 1318.5 feet and plant Limestone 14x10x3, N $\frac{1}{4}$. I then direct the true line between the N $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ posts and plant Limestone 16x12x3, marked on the East side NW $\frac{1}{4}$. I then plant at the WN $\frac{1}{4}$ temporary post, Limestone 16x14x3, marked on south side WN $\frac{1}{4}$. all corner posts marked with + on top. O. Boyle and C. A. Bunker were chosen and duly sworn as chainmen. Recorded Feby, 21, 1907.
