

Survey No. 6, Section 1, Town 35th, South, Range 13th

Survey of a part of Section 1, Township 35, Range 13, East, ^{orderly} Feb. 18, 1907, by N. A. Devere. Feb. 22, 1907, notices sent to following persons, N. A. Devere, J. W. Pittibone, J. E. Stone and Thomas Steele, to meet at the residence of J. W. Pittibone March 7, 1907, at 8 o'clock a.m.

March 7, 1907, met at time and place appointed selected W. B. M. Williams and DeWitt as chainmen and were duly sworn, I went to the N.W. corner of the section found the stone planted by Co. Sur. Pittibone ran south on true line Va. $8^{\circ} 45'$ East to intersection of section line with the Sage Diminish Reserve, I find the distance to be 1629 feet, I set division stone ^{yellow weathered, and red sand stone, 24x11x6, marked + on top} on this true line 814.5 south of the north west corner of Sec., I then go to the N $\frac{1}{4}$ post run south on random 814.5 feet stake for division, on east line (temporary) run south on same line 803.5 feet find I 7.5 feet west of stone claimed to be N to stone no marks, I then advanced until March 14, 1907, at 8 o'clock a.m. At 8 o'clock a.m., March 14, 1907, I start at intersection of west line of Section 1 and the Sage Diminish Reserve line, run east on random line 2640 feet set stake for temporary N to post, continue on same line east and same Va. $8^{\circ} 30'$ to east line of section and find that I am 38.5 feet south of the intersection of this line and the Sage Diminish reserve, I then correct my temporary N to stake by moving same north 19.25 feet at this point I plant for my true N to post, a sand stone 24x7x6, marked N to also cross on top, I then set my transit over this stone turn my object line to a flag at the N to post and on this line at 814.5 feet south from the N to stone I plant a sand stone 18x7x6, marked + on top for division line between J. W. Pittibone and N. A. Devere, I then set my transit over this stone turn my object line to a flag at the division stone on west line and at 1320 feet west of my instrument I drive stake on true line, this finished the survey.
