## Order on Road Petition.

AND NOW, On this 19 day of September, A. D. 1910, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, begun and holden on the 19 day of September, A. D. 1910, there was presented to said Board for their consideration, a petition signed by J. W. Cooper and seventy others, praying for the location and establishment of a certain road, hereinafter described.

The Board do find as follows: First—That said petition is a legal one, and is signed by at least twelve householders of Montgomery County, Kansas, residing in the vicinity of the road prayed for. Second—That the proper bond required by law has been filed, signed by J. W. Cooper as principal and J. E. McMeen and B. P. Welch as sureties, which said bond is by the Board approved.

THEREUPON, The Board orders that a view and survey of said proposed road be had on the 14 day of October, A. D. 1910, and appoints Jasper Swan and E. I. Burton, and J. H. Downing, three disinterested householders of Montgomery County, as viewers of said road, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor of Montgomery County, at the place of beginning of said proposed road in Hawes Creek Township, and proceed to view and survey the same, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof, as the law directs.

The Board further orders the County Clerk to prepare for publication, in the official newspaper of the County, a notice which shall contain a correct and pertinent description of said proposed location and establishment of road, which said notice is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

## ROAD NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That on the 19 day of September, A. D. 1910, a petition signed by J. W. Cooper and others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County and State aforesaid, praying for the location and establishment of a certain road, described as follows, viz.: commencing about 94 rods south of the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 35, Range 16, said County, and about 115 rods west of the East line of said quarter section at the point where the Coffeyville-Caney public road turns toward the Northeast, thence East about 155 rods to the edge of the cultivated land in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 5, said Twp. and range, thence in a Northerly direction around the foot of the hill and as near to the same as practicable to a point on the said Coffeyville-Caney Public road near the foot of what is known as the "Allin Hill" on said road.

WHEREUPON, Said Board of County Commissioners appointed the following-named persons, viz.: Jasper Swan and E. I. Burton, and J. H. Downing, as viewers, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning of said proposed road in Hawes Creek Township, on the 14 day of October, A. D. 1910, and proceed to view said road, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof as the law directs.

## FINAL ORDER.

NOW, On this day, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, begun and holden on the 17 day of October, A. D. 1910, comes on for hearing the report of the viewers and surveyor upon the Location of a road petitioned for by J. W. Cooper and others, praying for the Location and Establishment of a road described as follows, to wit:

commencing about 94 rods South of the North line of the Northeast Quarter of Sec. 6, Twp. 35, Range 16, said County, and about 115 rods West of the East line of said quarter section at the point where the Coffeyville-Caney public road turns toward the Northeast, thence East about 155 rods to the edge of the cultivated land in the NW 1/4 of Sec. 5, said Twp. and range, thence in a Northerly direction around the foot of the hill and as near to the same as practicable to a point on the said Coffeyville-Caney public road near the foot of what is known as the "Allin Hill" on said road

The Viewers on the road above described report that the same out out to be established whereupon the Commissioners approved the report of the viewers

The Board finds thereon as follows: First—That notice of the view and survey of said road has been given by advertisement in the Montgomery County, Kansas, a newspaper published and of general circulation in Montgomery County, Kansas, for two consecutive weeks, the last publication of which was not more than twenty days prior to the time appointed for the view and survey thereof, in pursuance of an order made at the 19 meeting of said Board; that a copy of said notice has been set up in the County Clerk's office, and in every municipal township through which any part of said road was designated to be for at least twenty days next preceding the view and survey thereof. Second—That the proper notices have been given in writing to the owners and agents of owners through whose lands such road is proposed to be at least six days prior to the view and survey thereof.

THEREFORE, Upon due consideration, and no legal objection having been made against the road of said road, and believing the same will be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers' report of view, surveyor's report of survey, and his plat thereof, be accepted and adopted, and said road in accordance therewith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the County Clerk make a record of said road in the County Road Records, including field-notes and plat; also, that the County Clerk notify the Trustee of Township to cause said road to be for public travel to a width of feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That warrants issue to the following-named persons, for amounts stated, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road, to wit:
