This is to certify that S. L. Hibbard Co. Surveyor was ordered by Mr. M. H. Coleman to Survey and Subdivide Sec. 4, T. 33, R. 17 East, on November 15th 1917. The following named parties were notified that a Survey of the above named Section Survey to begin on Nov 21st 1917. Mrs. M. H. Coleman; G. W. Bout; J. J. Blom; L. C. Giesman; J. M. Maudeow; William E. & Cindrella Hall; Mrs. Jos. Rodgers; G. W. Furse; B. M. Bellairs; Lavora J. Bellairs; M. J. T. R. Ferne; A. B. Turner and Mary O'Leary. On Nov 21st 1917 began the Survey of L. Rodee and L. J. Allen now known as claimant, B. M. Bellairs as claimant, from the North East corner a stone which has been there to my knowledge 34 years now standing on the edge of a depression, 200 ft. south on East line of sec. 4, at 345 feet North bank Bighill Creek bottom from top bank to top bank, at 2598 ft. made mark on Concrete floor boulders as temporary post on East side sec. 4, bearing of this line is N. 30° West. From this temporary post south 40° 30' West at 2480 ft. center of road stakes & new selection road to old 34 years go down stake at temp. S.E. for sec. 4, from this to 200 ft. N.E. at 1838 ft. down stake keep to left at 2674 ft. down stake at 2674 ft. down stake at 2674 ft. down stake near north bank of Bighill Creek public road along all others used to be, but now filled several feet over it. To post this point 200 ft. South to thick W. Cr. for 9.133 R. 17 E. Measured North 5280 ft. comes out with a stake, left original stake at true point for sec. 4. From this established corner & ran N. 20° E. at 2230 ft. South bank Bighill Creek, at 2744 ft. down stake as midpoint for 1/4 post original post, stone is in fill in making road, stone was standing at this point as N.W. Cr. of Coleman land 30 years ago. From this 1/4 post 200 ft. ran North 10° 30' East at 2389 ft. Stone N. W. Cr. Sec. 4, on Township line from this stone & ran South 89° 20' East on Township line of 2694 ft. Stone 1/4 Cr. from this stone & ran S. 89° E. at 2752 ft. N.E. for sec. 4, place of Beginning, quit for the day, Nov 22nd 1917 Survey Continued. B. M. Bellairs assisted for 1/4 post on South line sec. 4, & set a sand stone marker X. 8x12x8" a 2 inch iron pipe 4 ft. long as witness. For S. W. Cr. Sec. 4 & set a lime stone 20x15x8" Marker 1111 for Jones to Sects 4, 5, 8 & 9. This stone is where all our old 30 years ago witnesses. For N.W. Cr. Sec. 4 & set a lime stone 18x10x8" a 2 inch iron pipe 4 ft. long beside it, ran East on Random line S. 89° 15' E. at 1210 ft. bighill bank (road bank), 1575 ft. North bank bighill creek at 2100 ft. road bank bighill creek at 2300 ft. down at 2684 1/2 ft. stakes on N. & S. 1/4 lines. from this stake (and further) sec. 4, I ran S. 87° 10' E. at 2800 ft. came out 36 ft. North of 1/4 post on East line sec. 4. It contained 18 ft. South which brought it N. 10° E. + 18 ft. Hedges (old lines), from the 1/4 post on the South side of sec. 4, I ran N. on 1/4 lines at 2448 ft. E. + N. 1/4 lines down stake at temp. center sec. 4, from this stake I ran N. 10° 43' E. at 1073 ft. down at 1500 ft. South bank Bighill Creek, at 2459 ft. down at 24 ft. West of 1/4 Cr. (the old stone) on North line sec. 4. Precision for center overall to 12 ft. East here & connected center Cr. & down stake at true center (and) to sec. 4. quit for the day, quit for the day. Nov. 24th 1917 Survey Sec. 4 continued assisted by Joe Lorbel & B. M. Bellairs as the Center of sec. 4. I set a lime stone 16x11x8" Marker X, and 2" iron pipe besides it, 2" 1/4 ft. long as witness, at a point midway between the center of sec. 4, and the 1/4 post on the East side of said section, I set a lime 18x12x8" Marker X, with 2" iron pipe 4 ft. long as witness, this finished the survey, all out side lines of this section are angled at 1/4 posts, but are (the owners) after the government put them, or where the stones were located, 32 years ago, as & have had several occasions to make Survey & roads adjoining & houses guyed standing. the flat on opposite page shows creek & draw crossings.
