

FIELD NOTES OF SURVEY NO.

Hamilton & Co., Manufacturers, Topeka, Kansas

v $10^{\circ} 45'$ of set temporary corner at 40 chains and intersected the Sth Wth Sec. line at 80.95 chains and 2 links West of the corner to Secs 15, 16, 21 & 22. South true or $9^{\circ} 48'$

Commenced at the corner of Secs 15, 16, 21 & 22 ran West between Sections 16 & 21 v $10^{\circ} 47'$ and set temporary corners at 10.60 and 80 chains, at 68.68 link from Creek 5.5 links wide. Hence West between Secs 17 & 20 v $10^{\circ} 14'$ and intersected West boundary of the Osage "Deeded" lands, and 4 chains E of the 24th mile. To test the 29th Mile saw the West boundary of the Osage "Deeded" land I commenced at the 30th Mile Stone and ran North and recorded ran the treaty line and intersected the 6th Standard Parallel at 321.90 ch and 42.3 links West of the 26th Mile Post. Correction is 105 link E to the mile and 15 link S to the mile.

At the intersection of the E and N.W.S. Sec lines I established the corner to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21 of lime rock about 24x12x3 inches. I then measured to the Creek and found it to be 11.80 chains and the measurement E from the corner to the Creek was 28.80 chains.
