

Road Petitioned for by R. L. Grisham and others.

Order on Road Petition

AND NOW, On this 14th day of April, A. D. 1926, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, begun and holden on the 14th day of April, A. D. 1926, there was presented to said Board for their consideration, a petition signed by R. L. Grisham and 27 others, praying for the location of a certain road, hereinafter described.

The Board do find as follows: First—That said petition is a legal one, and is signed by at least twelve householders of Montgomery County, Kansas, residing in the vicinity of the road prayed for. Second—That the proper bond required by law has been filed, signed by R. L. Grisham as principal and George S. Taylor and George S. Taylor as sureties, which said bond is by the Board approved.

THEREUPON, The Board orders that a view and survey of said proposed location be had on the 17th day of May, A. D. 1926, and appoints D. A. Cline, J. R. Jones, and George Smith, three disinterested householders of Montgomery County, as viewers of said road, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor of Montgomery County, at the designated place of beginning in Parker Township, and proceed to view and survey the same, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof, as the law directs.

The Board further orders the County Clerk to prepare for publication, in the official newspaper of the County, a notice which shall contain a correct and pertinent description of said proposed location of road, which said notice is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ROAD NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That on the 14th day of April, A. D. 1926, a petition signed by R. L. Grisham and 27 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County and State aforesaid, praying for the location of a certain road, described as follows, viz.:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SW⁴ of the NW⁴ of Sec 2 Township 34 Range 16 East Thence South on Sec line bet. Secs 2 & 3 about 1/2 miles to the foot of the bluff. Thence in a southerly direction around the foot of the bluff intersecting road No 102. Thence East and South along the center line of said road No 102 to the west bank of the Verdigris river. Thence in a southerly direction along the west bank of the Verdigris river or the foot of the bluff to the north end of road No 382 at the 1/4 line running East and West through Sec 23-34-16. Distance about 3 1/2 miles. Said road would cross Secs 2, 11 & 14 to the center line of Sec 23.

WHEREUPON, Said Board of County Commissioners appointed the following-named persons, viz.: D. A. Cline, J. R. Jones, and George Smith, as viewers, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning of said road, in Parker Township, on the 17th day of May, A. D. 1926, and proceed to view said road, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof as the law directs.

FINAL ORDER.

NOW, On this day, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, begun and holden on the 29th day of January, A. D. 1927, comes on for hearing the report of the viewers and surveyor upon the location of a road petitioned for by R. L. Grisham and others, praying for the location of a road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the SW⁴ of the NW⁴ of Sec 2 Township 34 Range 16 East thence South on sec line bet Sec 2 & 3 about 1/2 mile to foot of the bluff thence in a southerly direction around the foot of the bluff intersecting road No 102 thence East and south along the center line of said road No 102 to the west bank of the Verdigris river thence in a southerly direction along the west bank of the Verdigris river or the foot of the bluff to the north end of road No 382 at the quarter (1/4) line running east & west through Sec 23-34-16. Distance about 3 1/2 miles said road would cross Sec 2-11-14 center line of Sec 23.

The Board finds thereon as follows: First—That notice of the view and survey of said location has been given by advertisement in the Boffeyville Journal, a newspaper published and of general circulation in Montgomery County, Kansas, for two consecutive weeks, the last publication of which was not more than twenty days prior to the time appointed for the view and survey thereof, in pursuance of an order made at the April, 1926, meeting of said Board; that a copy of said notice has been set up in the County Clerk's office, and in every municipal township through which any part of said road was designated to be located, for at least twenty days next preceding the view and survey thereof. Second—That the proper notices have been given in writing to the owners and agents of owners through whose lands such road is proposed to be located at least six days prior to the view and survey thereof.

THEREFORE, Upon due consideration, and no legal objection having been made against the location of said road, and believing the same will be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers' report of view, surveyor's report of survey, and his plat thereof, be accepted and adopted, and said road located in accordance therewith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the location make a record of said road in the County Road Records, including field notes and plat; also, that the location notify the Trustees of Parker Township to cause said road to be located for public travel to a width of 40 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That warrants issue to the following-named persons, for amounts stated, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road, to wit:

The board being fully advised in the matter it is ordered, that the said report be rejected and said road be not allowed as prayed for in said petition.
