


FIELD NOTES OF SURVEY NO.

Surveyor's Report, of a Private Survey made in Section 5 Township 33 South, of Range 16 East of the 6th P.M. Commenced on the 5th day of May and closed on the 28th day of May for A.E. Bradley. On the 5th day of April 1879 I received the following order as per Order Book "Order of Survey No 56" Surveyor's Office Montgomery County, Kansas April 1879. "Al Savage Surveyor, you will at your earliest convenience and according to law survey and trace the section line between Sections 5 of Township 33 and Section 32 of Township 32 all in Range 16 E. of the 6th P.M. and establish the N.E. Corner of the N.W. of the N.W. My land lying in Section 5 T. 33 R. 16 E. You also notify A. Brooks of such survey who is interested in the corner and boundaries of my land." Signed A.E. Bradley Independence

In accordance with the above on the 19th day of April 1879 I issued and on the 19th day of April I served the notice on the interested parties as required by law. The following is a true copy of the same. To A.E. Bradley and A. Brooks. You are hereby notified that I will bear the residue of A. Brooks and the 30th day of April 1879 at 9 o'clock A.M. for the purpose of surveying the lands of A.E. Bradley lying in Section 5 T. 33 R. 16 E. You will therefore be prepared to pay your proportionate part of the expenses of said survey in accordance with the Act of Independence this 19th day of April 1879. Al Savage Surveyor of Montgomery County. The day appointed was very rainy and the work was adjourned till May the 5th 1879.

Montgomery County 3d. Be it known that on the 5th day of May 1879 personally appeared before me Al Savage a surveyor in and for said County James Shaw and W.P. Brown as Chainmen and J.P. Stephenson as Flagman and Cornman in a survey of Section 5 Township 33 Range 16 E. of the 6th P.M. now by me duly sworn to faithfully and to the best of their ability and skill discharge their respective duties. Signed Al Savage "Survey" On the 5th day of May in accordance with the above order, notice and adjournment I proceeded to trace the said Sec. line. I commenced at the Corner to Sections 5, 6, 31 and 32 and ran East on a random line between Sections 5 and 32 = 2000 Chains Set Temporary Corner = 3200 Feet Creek 100 links wide = 3500 Top of Rocky Bluff = 4000 Intersected N.W. 1/2 Section line at 16 links South of the 1/2 Section Corner between Sections 5 and 32 S 89° 46' W on true line between Sections 5 and 32 59° 15' E = 2000 Set a line rock 36x15x5 (marked saw N. side) for the N.E. corner of the N.W. of the N.W. = 1000 Corner to Section 5, 6, 31 and 32
