## Order on Road Petition

AND NOW, On this 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, A. D. 1926, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, begun and holden on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, A. D. 1926, there was presented to said Board for their consideration, a petition signed by F. H. Grans and 16 others, praying for the Location of a certain road, hereinafter described.

The Board do find as follows: First—That said petition is a legal one, and is signed by at least twelve householders of Montgomery County, Kansas, residing in the vicinity of the road prayed for. Second—That the proper bond required by law has been filed, signed by F. H. Grans as principal and William Inge and S. N. Matthews as sureties, which said bond is by the Board approved.

THEREUPON, The Board orders that a view and survey of said proposed Location of road be had on the First day of February, A. D. 1927, and appoints R. F. Burke, Isaac Harter, and J. F. Callahan, three disinterested householders of Montgomery County, as viewers of said road, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor of Montgomery County, at the designated place of beginning, in Independence Township, and proceed to view and survey the same, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof, as the law directs.

The Board further orders the County Clerk to prepare for publication, in the official newspaper of the County, a notice which shall contain a correct and pertinent description of said proposed Location of road, which said notice is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

## ROAD NOTICE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, A. D. 1926, a petition signed by F. H. Grans and 16 others, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County and State aforesaid, praying for the Location of a certain road, described as follows, viz.: Commencing at the center of the west end of Cherry Street in Blooms Addition to the City of Independence, thence in a westerly direction to the North east corner of the South-west quarter (1/4) of the South west quarter (1/4) of Section thirty six (36) Township thirty two (32) Range Fifteen (15) East. Thence due west to the North west corner of the Southeast quarter (1/4) of the South east quarter (1/4) of Section thirty five (35) Township thirty two (32) Range fifteen (15) Montgomery County Kansas

WHEREUPON, Said Board of County Commissioners appointed the following-named persons, viz.: J. F. Burke, Isaac Harter, and J. F. Callahan, as viewers, with instructions to meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, in Independence Township, on the First day of February, A. D. 1927, and proceed to view said road, give to all parties a hearing, and make report thereof as the law directs.

## FINAL ORDER.

NOW, On this day, being one of the days of the regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, begun and holden on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February, A. D. 1927, comes on for hearing the report of the viewers and surveyor upon the Location of a road petitioned for by F. H. Grans and others, praying for the Location and Establishment of a road described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the west end of Cherry Street in Blooms Addition to the City of Independence Montgomery County Kansas Section 36 Township 32 Range 15 East running thence West on the 1/4 line to the SW Center 1/4 stake being a distance of 118 ft and the viewers herein appointed deems that that this part of said road shall be 5 ft as follows South of said 1/4 line 25 ft and North of said line 5 ft running thence West on said line from the said SW Center 1/4 stake 1320 to the SW 1/4 stone thence West from said South West 1/4 stone on the East and West 1/4 line to the South East Center 1/4 stake in Sec 35 Twp 32 Range 15 East a distance of 1320 ft thence intersecting with the wagon road running North and South on the North and South 1/4 line of the SE 1/4 of Section 35 Twp 32 R 15 E. The said Viewers making their order that the last described part of said road 50 ft the same being 25 ft on each side of above described 1/4 line the said road crosses the Mo Pac RR at and on either side of the above described South West Center 1/4 stake in section 36 Township 32 Range 15 East

The Board finds thereon as follows: First—That notice of the view and survey of said Proposed Road has been given by advertisement in the Jeffersonville Journal, a newspaper published and of general circulation in Montgomery County, Kansas, for two consecutive weeks, the last publication of which was not more than twenty days prior to the time appointed for the view and survey thereof, in pursuance of an order made at the December, 1926, meeting of said Board; that a copy of said notice has been set up in the County Clerk's office, and in every municipal township through which any part of said road was designated to be Located, for at least twenty days next preceding the view and survey thereof. Second—That the proper notices have been given in writing to the owners and agents of owners through whose lands such road is proposed to be Located at least six days prior to the view and survey thereof.

THEREFORE, Upon due consideration, and no legal objection having been made against the Establishment of said road, and believing the same will be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers' report of view, surveyor's report of survey, and his plat thereof, be accepted and adopted, and said road Established and Opened in accordance therewith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That the County Surveyor make a record of said road in the County Road Records, including field-notes and plat; also, that the County Clerk notify the Trustee of Independence Township to cause said road to be Opened for public travel to a width of 50 feet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That warrants issue to the following-named persons, for amounts stated, in full compensation for all damages occasioned by the location and establishment of said road, to wit:
