

FIELD NOTES OF SURVEY NO.

February 14th 1891 I was ordered by Abraham Royer and L. D. Farbro to survey and subdivide the South 1/2 of section 27 Township 33 R. 17 E. On Feb 18th 1891 The following named parties were notified that a survey of the above named section would be made on March 3rd 1891. - Thomas Crowley, Peter Starty, L. D. Farbro and wife, W. A. Kaunrah (J. Shaw agent), Allen Nicholson, Abraham Royer, March 3rd 1891 I proceeded to survey and subdivide the South 1/2 of section 27, T. 33 R. 17. E. J. S. Musfly and C. G. Reynolds were selected as chain carriers and were duly sworn, began at the 1/4 post on the west side of section 27. Ran South 1°30' N. in center of public highway at 2642 ft. found the South West corner of the above named section standing to divide this 1/4 equally I set a line stone 15" x 10" x 5" marked X at 1321 ft N. 1°30' E. from the South West corner of the section. I then ran S. 88° 25' E. in center of Road at 2656 ft found a hedge running N. 78 through the center of section 27. In order to hit the S.E. corner of section 27 I ran from temporary 1/4 post S. 88° E. which makes an angle of 85 ft with a line joining the S. E. & S. W. corners shown by plat I then went to the center of section 34 and measured North to temporary 1/4 post by so doing found that the line could not be straight as the 1/4 post on the North line of section 27 and also the center corner were standing as also the center corner of section 34. and was marked stone I located the 1/4 post between section 27 and 34. as shown by plat I measured the distance between center of section 27 and the 1/4 post on South line of section 27. which I found to be 2653 ft. at 1326 1/2 ft North of 1/4 post I set a sand stone 13" x 9" x 3 1/2" marked X. For the 1/4 post set, a sand stone 20" x 13" x 4" marked 1/4 also drove an iron pin 4 ft long marked 3 notches by it. I then ran from the center of section 27 to the 1/4 post on the East line found the distance to be 2633 ft. at 1316 1/2 ft East on a straight line joining the corner I set a sand stone 12" x 6" x 4" marked pr. S.W. corner of S. 1/2 of N.E. 1/4 of section 27


