

# FIELD NOTES OF SURVEY NO. 3

Hamilton & Carl, Manufacturers - Topeka, Kansas

Report of Private Survey made in Section 36, Township 32 South in Range 15 East of the  
6th P.M. on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1879 for G. Gottlieb: On the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1879 I received  
the following as per Order Book. Order of Survey No 69: Surveyor's Office In-  
dependence Montgomery County Kansas May 21<sup>st</sup> 1879. A. Savage Surveyor: You  
will at your earliest convenience and according to law survey my land lying in Section 36,  
Township 32 South in Range 15 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. You will also notify G. Gottlieb, Lizzie  
Cheney by her agent A. Humphrey and O'Connor, W.C. McKnight, A.M. Turner, Mag-  
gie Rosner and L.C. Mason who are interested in the corner and boundaries of my land.

In accordance with the above order on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1879 I went and on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
May I served notice on the interested parties and required by law, the following is a true copy  
of the same: To G. Gottlieb, Lizzie Cheney by her Agents Humphrey & O'Connor, W.C. Mc-  
Knight, A.M. Turner, Maggie Rosner and L.C. Mason. You are hereby notified that I  
will be at the residence of Macedonian Mills on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1879 at 7 o'clock  
A.M. for the purpose of surveying the lands of G. Gottlieb in Sec 36, T. 32, R. 15 E.


You will therefore be prepared to pay your proportionate parts of the expense of said  
Survey in accordance with the Session Laws of 1879. Dated at Independence Kansas

Montgomery County 3, S. Be it remembered that on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1879 personally appear-  
ed before me A. Savage a Surveyor in and for said County James Snow and Jasper Debuela  
as chainmen and S.P. Fletcher flagman in Survey in Section 36, Township 32 Range 15 East of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. and were by them duly sworn to faithfully impartially as to the best of their ability to will  
to discharge their respective duties - A.J. Savage Surveyor

On the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May A.D. 1879 in accordance with the above order and Notice I proceeded to  
Survey and divide up the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of the SW<sup>1/4</sup> of said Sec = I commenced at the N corner between  
Sections 25<sup>th</sup> & 36 and ran South on a true line or 9° 15' E = 11.66% Set a sand stave 16x10x8  
marked A with an iron bolt with hole in top end = 20.00 At N. corner of the SW<sup>1/4</sup> of the  
NW<sup>1/4</sup> = Commenced at the N corner between Sections 25<sup>th</sup> & 36, Ran West on a random  
line between Sections 25<sup>th</sup> & 36 or 9° 15' E = 7.50 Set Pump. Corn. = 20.00 Intersected the NW<sup>1/4</sup> sub-  
division lines at the NW corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> North 10° East true line between Sec-  
tions 25<sup>th</sup> & 36 or 9° 15' E = 12.50 Set a line stave 16x8x6 marked A = 20.00 N. corner between Sec-  
tions 25<sup>th</sup> & 36 = Commenced at the NW corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> and ran South on a random  
line through the NW<sup>1/4</sup> or 9° 15' E = 11.66% Set Temporary corner = 20.00 Set Pump. Corn.  
corn Intersected the SW<sup>1/4</sup> Sec line 1/4 links N. of corner N. W. on true line through the  
center of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> or 9° 15' E = 20.00 Found true point for center of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> = 28.33%  
Found true point for corner = 20.00 The NW corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> = Commenced at  
the SW corner of the NW<sup>1/4</sup> Ran East a random line through the NW<sup>1/4</sup> or 9° 15' E

1/4 links S. of the corner between Secs 25<sup>th</sup> & 36 Ran West on true line between the lands  
of G. Gottlieb and Maggie Rosner or 9° 15' E = 7.50 Set a sand stave 16x8x6 mark-
