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This is to Certify that I, L. L. Hibbard County Surveyor of Montgomery Co. Kansas was ordered by A. J. Deenick County Surveyor of Chautauque County Kansas to meet him at the North West corner of Section 14 Township 35 Range 13 East and to establish said N.W. Cor of Sec. 14 T. & R. as above. On the 18 day of February 1899 the following named parties were notified of the survey to be made on. B. F. Lauble William Braden, U.S. Rep. on March 1st 1899. On March 1st 1899 we began the survey at 2 O'clock P.M. From a Stone the S.W. Corner of Section 14 which is on the National line we ran N. Lat 3725 ft. down stake center of cross roads old hedge planted by road side on Sec 11. this stake we made temporary for to Sect 11 & 14 from this temporary cor we ran North at 2632 1/2 ft. & post we set a sand stone 22" x 12" x 5" in. 1111 at a point at 3727 ft. north of the Stone on the national line. we proved this point by going west one mile to the N.W. corner of Sec. 15 & running East. this completed the survey. Var. 8° 15' E.
