

This is to certify that I, D. L. Hibbard County Surveyor of Montgomery Co. Kansas was ordered by J. Harrison to Survey and Subdivide Section Twelve (12) Township 33 Range 13 East.

On February 5, 1900 the following named parties were notified that a Survey of the above named Section would be made. The Survey to begin on the 14th day of February 1900

On February 14th 1900 I began the Survey J. C. Morris^{2d} & A. H. Hampton were selected as chairmen John H. Morris flagman all were duly sworn. As none of the corners to Section 12 T. 33, R. 13, E. 13 were standing on the East line of the Section I went South on the Range line found the Government $\frac{1}{4}$ post standing on the East line of Sec 13 T. 33 Range 13 E. From this $\frac{1}{4}$ post I ran north on the Range line 2640 ft drove a stake as temporary S. E. corner of Sec 12. From this temporary Sec corner I ran due north on the Range line at 2640 ft. drove stake as temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ corner (I found the Government Stone lying beside of the road.) From this temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ post I ran north from this stake at 1320 ft drove stake as temporary cor. for S. E. corner N $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 12, at 2640 ft drove stake as temporary north East corner of Sec 12. Quit for the day.

Feb 15. From Stake set at South East corner of Sec 12 I ran west at 2640 ft drove stake in center of North & South Road at 5280 ft. drove stake as temporary S. W. corner of Sec 12. From this temporary S. W. corner of Sec 12 I ran north through the timber at 2640 ft. found Government $\frac{1}{4}$ post. Marked but down From Stake driven as temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ post on West line of Section 12 I ran north at 2627 ft found Government Stone standing N. W. cor Section 12. From this N. W. corner I ran East at 2640 ft. drove stake as temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ post on North line of Section 12 From this Stake I ran east at 1320 ft drove stake at 2640 ft temporary N. E. cor. of Section 12, to make sure that this line was correct I put a Flag 25 ft high on the north West corner of

the day. Feb. 16 1900 Survey of Sec 12 continued I set for the $\frac{1}{4}$ post, on the east line of Sec 12 a Sand Stone 21" x 8" x 4" marked $\frac{1}{4}$ for the $\frac{1}{4}$ post. For $\frac{1}{4}$ post on South line of Section 12 I corrected the Stake 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft South and set a Sand Stone 22" x 10" x 5" marked $\frac{1}{4}$ for $\frac{1}{4}$ post on South line sec 12. At the South West corner Sec 12 I corrected Stake as temporary S. W. cor., 13 ft. South and set a Sand Stone 22" x 10" x 3" marked 1111 for S. W. cor Sec 12. I stake as temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ post on West line of Sec 12. I corrected 13 ft South and set a sand stone 20" x 10" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". I ran lines from the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the West line Sec 12 to the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the East line Sec 12 measured distance to center Sec 2640 ft. put flags on the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on South line & North line section 12 connected them by a straight line at the intersections of the $\frac{1}{4}$ lines I set a sand Stone 26" x 14" x 7" marked X as center sec 12. I also set a Sand Stone at a point midway from center of sec 12 to the $\frac{1}{4}$ post on the East line also gave points to set stones to divide N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 12 into 40 acre tracts by giving centers to side lines. This finished the survey.
