This is to certify that S. L. Hibbard County Surveyor was ordered by John McIntire to establish the  $\frac{1}{4}$  post on the South line of Section 29, Township 34, Range 17 East.

On February 7<sup>th</sup> 1901 the following named parties were notified that a survey to establish the above described point would be made on the 13 day of Feb, 1901 John McIntire, John Aiderer, Jacob Good. From a Recorded Survey made by me several years ago the  $\frac{1}{4}$  post was then standing I copied the distance and bearing and on the 13 day of Feb, 1901 I made the survey. J. J. Garlie & S. L. Hibbard were chainmen and were duly sworn. From the South West corner of Section 29, T. 34, R. 17 E. I ran S. 87° 30' E. drove stake at 1625 ft. on treaty line. From the point I ran N. 87° E. 1050 ft. here I set a lime stone 24x12x6 marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  for  $\frac{1}{4}$  post on South line of Sec 29, T. 34 R. 17, this places the stone where it has been for the last 20 years, this completed the survey.
