The first discussion was on the dental health plan and the networks. The County is presently in the Ameritas network and it is recommended we change to Delta Dental network for better service and a savings to the County.

Increasing the out-of-pocket expenses when having services outside of Coffeyville Medical Center and Labette Health, (our Preferred Providers), was discussed. The out-of-pocket would go to \$2,000 and is presently \$1,500. No change was made on this recommendation.

Mr. Boulanger is working on the agreement with Coffeyville Medical Center on continuing the present agreement as a Preferred Provider. He has already spoke with Labette Health and they wish to continue with the present agreement.
