TOURISM REPORTS:

Representatives from Caney, Cherryvale, Coffeyville and Independence met with the Board on the tourism tax collected.

Cherryvale City Administration reported they are spending their funds trying to work with the Chambers of Commerce getting events sponsored for more activities in Cherryvale. They are also work with the Bass Tournament at Big Hill Lake.

Caney City Administrator Kelley Zellner gave his report and they are working on getting signage for downtown Caney and advertise tourism in Caney.

Coffeyville City Chamber of Commerce Director Candi Westbrook gave a report on this being 50th anniversary and they are working on the celebration. They are also working on getting a theater in Coffeyville and also have created a "Visitor Map" which also includes activities throughout the County.

TOURISM (Continued):

Independence City Chamber of Commerce Director Lisa Wilson and Maggie Moore met with the Board. A notebook was presented to each of the Board Members with their activities, reaching out to advertise the activities was presented by illustrations in the notebook and various magazines advertising Independence and Montgomery County Activities.

The Board thanked each of the representatives for their presentations.

PUBLIC WORKS:

Public Works Coordinator Jim Wright and Assistant Coordinator Brandon Beurskens to present the weekly written report to the Board. The following items were discussed:

- Discussion regarding Safe Streets for All Awards. Information on all funding of the awards was
 presented to the Board, Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission was awarded
 \$800,000.00 for the Southeast Kansas Regional SS4A Planning Grant Application.
- 2. Request permission to purchase a used dump truck for the Special Bridge Crew. This truck will replace the truck wrecked in November. Mr. Wright was approved to purchase a dump truck with under 250,000 miles and the cost for \$80,000. He will work with Commissioner McManus to make a purchase.
- 3. Noxious Weed One Ton Truck:

October of 2022 bids were taken on a one-ton truck for Noxious Weed Department. A letter was received from Quality Motors that the truck they were awarded to bid on would not be built due to Ford's production restraints. On February 7th, 2023 Quality Motors informed the County they had a 2022 similar truck and would the County be interested and will discount the price for being a 22 year model. After a discussion the following action was taken:


