Mr. Phillip Eastep met with the Board to request the \$2,000.00 allowed for the Independence AWOL Animal Shelter be increased for the 2024 budget due to expenses and the number of stray animals from the rural areas being brought to the shelter. He provided information on the rural area and Independence City. The number of stray animals brought to the shelter is about 500 with 300 being from the city of Independence and 200 from the rural areas. Funding provided by the city is \$3,000.00 per month.
