# A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-101 et seq. authorizes counties within Kansas to exercise the powers of home rule in order to transact county business and perform powers of local legislation and administration as deemed appropriate by such county; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-3a02 authorizes the board of county commissioners of any county to adopt a resolution establishing the office of county administrator; and

WHEREAS, the board of county commissioners of Montgomery County, Kansas, finds it in in the best interests of Montgomery County to establish the position of county administrator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The position of county administrator for Montgomery County is hereby established.
- Section 2. The county administrator shall be the chief administrative officer of Montgomery County and shall have the powers and duties, and be subject to the limitations, as set forth in K.S.A. 19-3a04.
- Section 3. The human resources officer is authorized to develop a job description for the position of county administrator.
- Section 4. The compensation of the county administrator shall be determined by the board of county commissioners.
- Section 5. The board of commissioners shall appoint a county administrator within six months following the effective date of this resolution, as required by K.S.A. 19-3a03(a).

Section 6. This resolution shall be in force from and after its adoption as provided by law.
