Shall the City of Coffeyville, Kansas, be authorized, pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-187 et seq., to continue imposing a one-half percent (0.5%) Citywide retailers' sales tax (the "Sales Tax"), the proceeds of which shall be used to finance the costs of general transportation improvements throughout the City including, but not limited to streets, curbing, and sidewalks; provided that the collection of the Sales Tax shall commence on April 1, 2025, or as soon thereafter as permitted by law, and shall expire ten (10) years after its commencement?

To vote in favor of any question submitted on this ballot, press the word "Yes" on the voting machine or completely darken the oval to the left of the word "Yes" on the paper ballot. To vote against it, press the word "No" on the voting machine or completely darken the oval to the left of the word "No" on the paper ballot.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The following additional information is provided by the City with respect to the impact of this ballot question.

2025 Transportation Sales Tax. Passage of this ballot proposition would authorize the City to continue imposing a one-half percent (0.50%) City-wide retailers' sales tax (the "2025 Transportation Sales Tax") to finance the costs of general transportation improvements throughout the City including,

but not limited to streets, curbing, and sidewalks. Collection of the 2025 Transportation Sales Tax, if approved by the electors of the City, shall commence on April 1, 2025, or as soon thereafter as permitted by the Act, and shall expire ten (10) years after its commencement.

Existing Sales Taxes. Pursuant to approval of the electors at prior elections, the City currently imposes City-wide retailers' sales taxes in the aggregate amount of 3%, which will change to 2.5% on April 1, 2025. If the imposition of the 2025 Transportation Sales Tax is approved, beginning April 1, 2025, the amount of City-wide retailers' sales taxes levied by the City would be at the aggregate rate of 3%.
